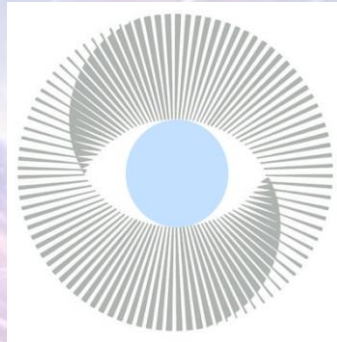

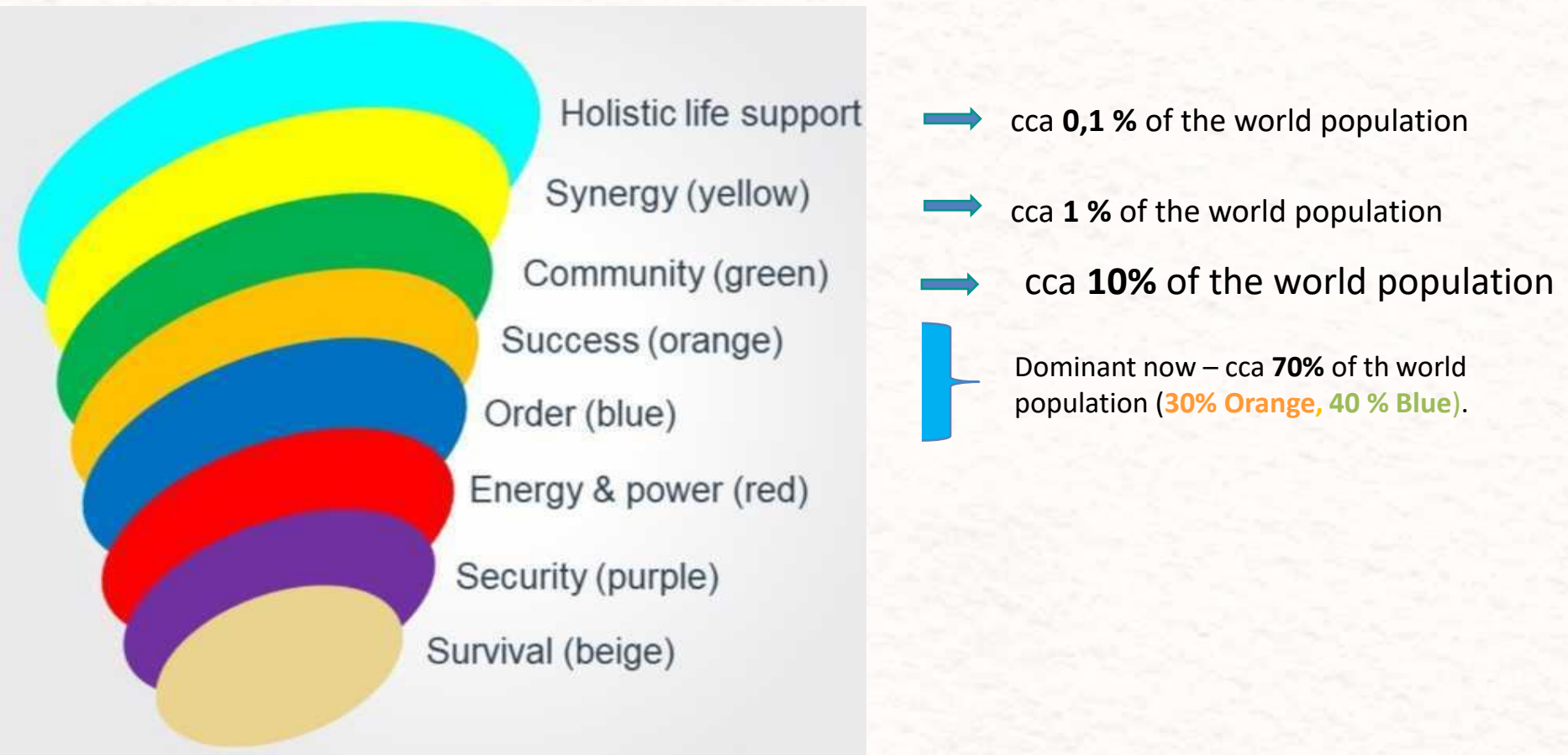

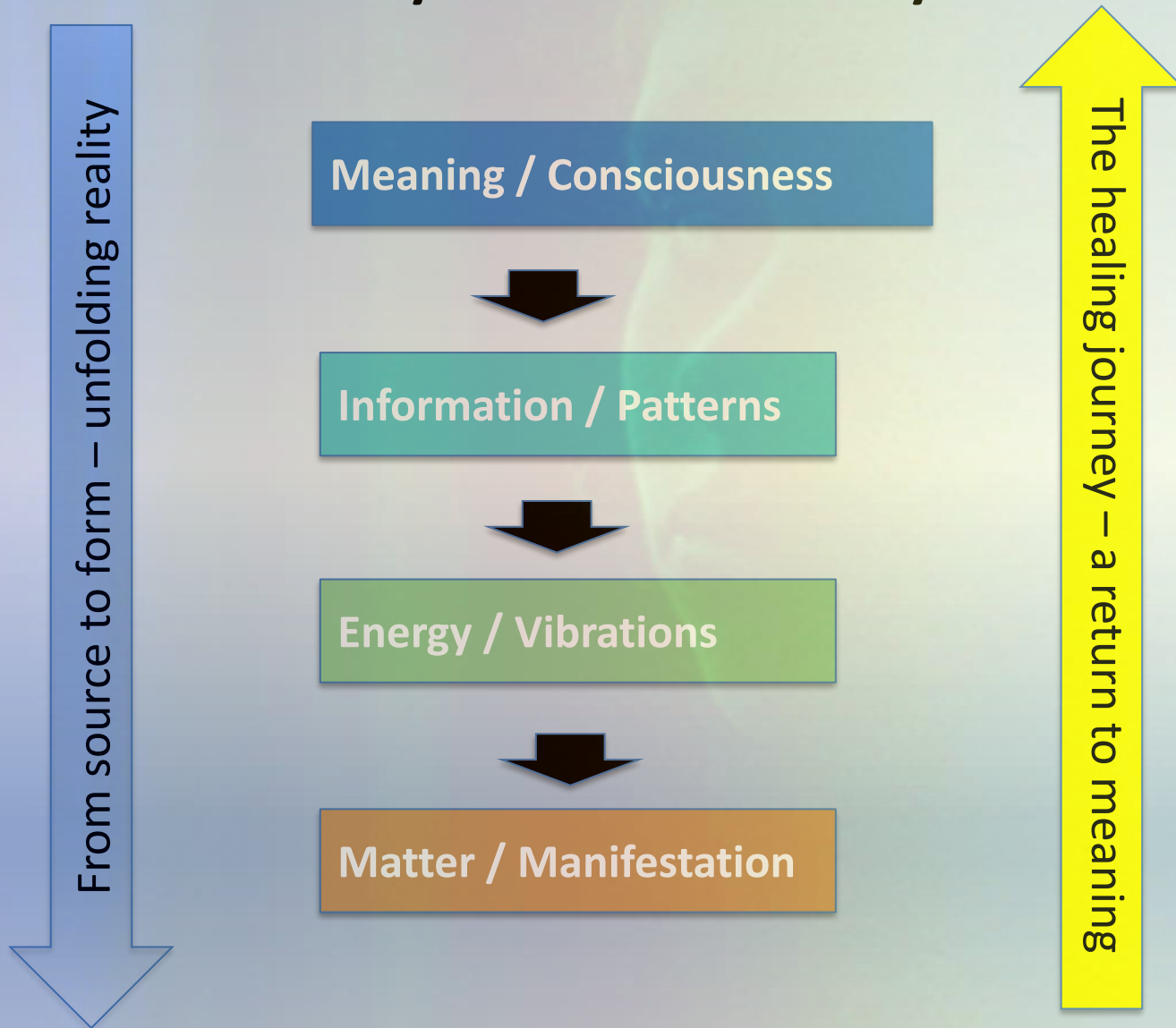

Principles of the new worldview

1. **Ontological primitive is consciousness – idealism.**
2. **Non locality** - derived from **contextuality** and **holographic model** of the universe.
3. **Interconnectedness** of the whole and all parts.
4. **Holonic nestedness** – complex systems are part of even more complex systems. Hierarchy, stratification, levels of reality.
5. **Border** – polarity, ambiguity and multipolarity as a source of self-organisation.
6. Consciousness is communicating with itself by **signs and symbols**. **Semiotics** is important part of the new paradigm.
7. Deeper reality is meaningful. Meaning is conveyed to us via **phenomena as a symbolic language** of nature.

From Consciousness to Matter – 4 Layers of Reality



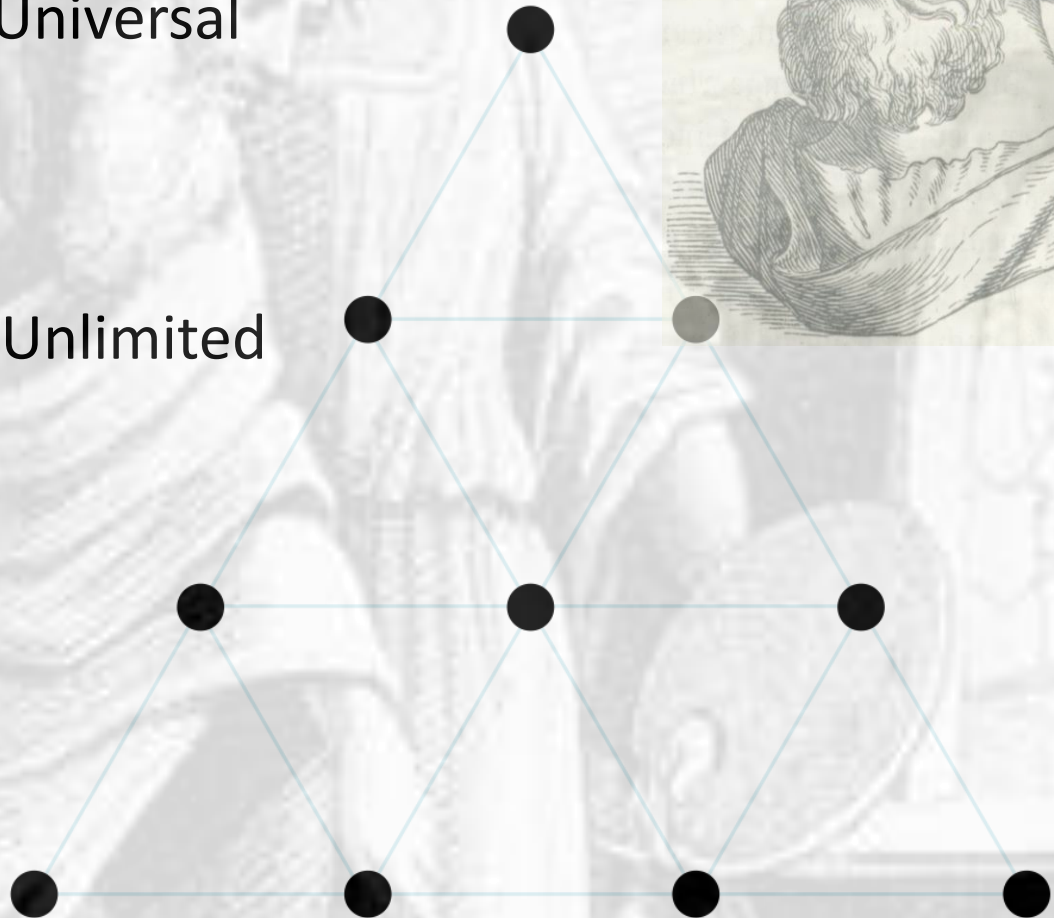
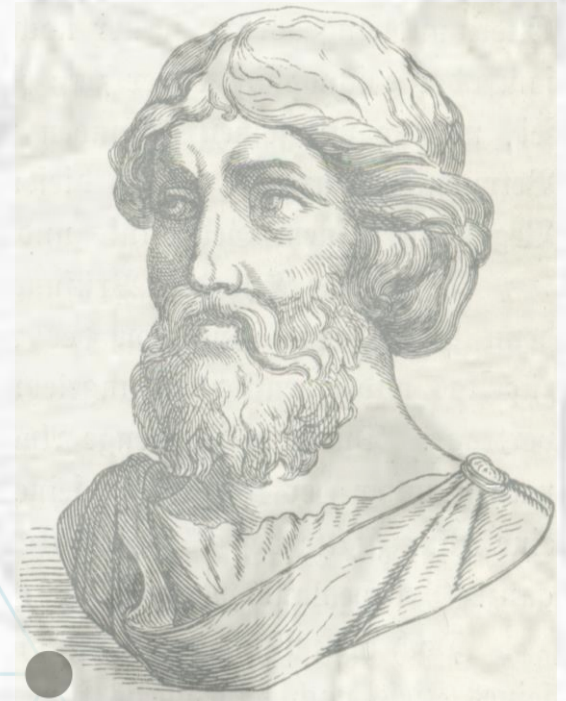

From Consciousness to Matter – 4 Nested Layers of Reality

1. **Meaning / Consciousness** – Source, timeless awareness
2. **Information** – Archetypes, symbolic patterns, quantum fields
3. **Energy** – Vibrations, interference, motion
4. **Matter** – Manifestation, structured energy

Levels of reality:

1. Universal consciousness

2. Form, Pattern, vessel, separation

3. Reality as a hologram

4. Headset, perceived, material reality

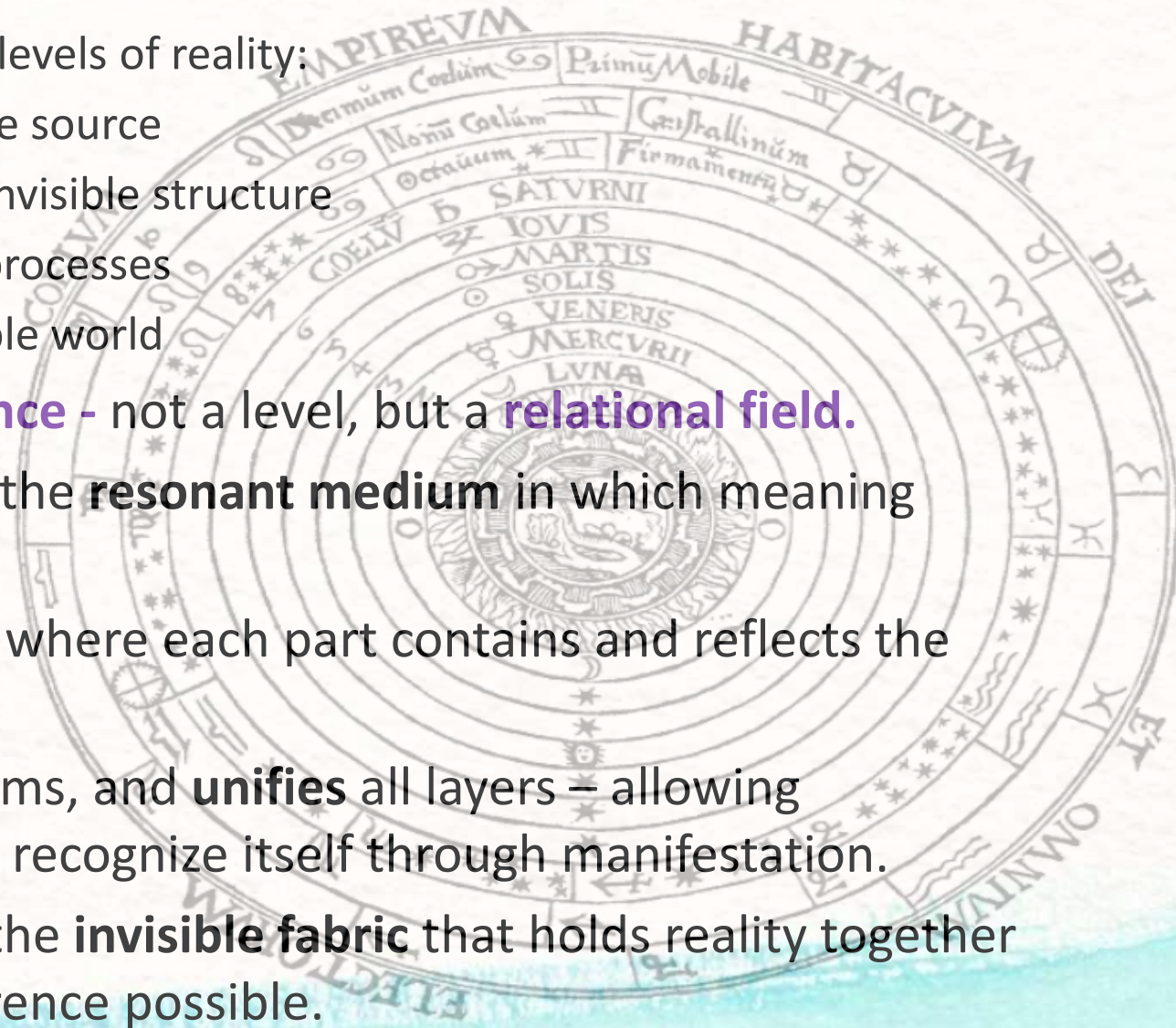
The Fifth Essence – Quintessence (aether / dark energy)

In addition to the four levels of reality:

1. **Consciousness** – the source
2. **Information** – the invisible structure
3. **Energy** – dynamic processes
4. **Matter** – the tangible world

there is a **fifth essence** - not a level, but a **relational field**.

- It is the **context**, the **resonant medium** in which meaning emerges.
- Like a **hologram**, where each part contains and reflects the whole.
- It connects, informs, and **unifies** all layers – allowing consciousness to recognize itself through manifestation.
- Quintessence is the **invisible fabric** that holds reality together and makes coherence possible.



Quintessence as the Holographic Principle of the Universe

- **Quintessence** is not a fifth material element, but the **invisible matrix of resonance and coherence** that **connects all levels of reality**.
- In the ancient worldview, it was the **aether** — the subtle substance linking heavens and earth.
- In modern cosmology, it is used as a name for **dark energy** — a field that permeates space and influences cosmic evolution.
- In the **holographic model**, quintessence is the **field in which the whole is reflected in each part**. Meaning arises here — not from force, but from **resonance**.
- It is where **consciousness meets form** and **the symbolic becomes real**.
In this sense, **quintessence is the holographic field of meaning** — the space where consciousness recognizes itself in the mirror of creation.

Three aspects of consciousness

1. Source of consciousness

- ◆ That from which everything originates
- ◆ Cosmic consciousness, the essence of reality
- ◆ Silence, presence, Being

2. Essence of consciousness

- ◆ That which consciousness is in its nature
- ◆ Self-reflection, relationality, resonance
- ◆ The field in which consciousness becomes aware of itself

3. The process of consciousness

- ◆ How consciousness works in reality
- ◆ Perception, meaning, identity formation
- ◆ Reflection between levels, connections between the self and the world

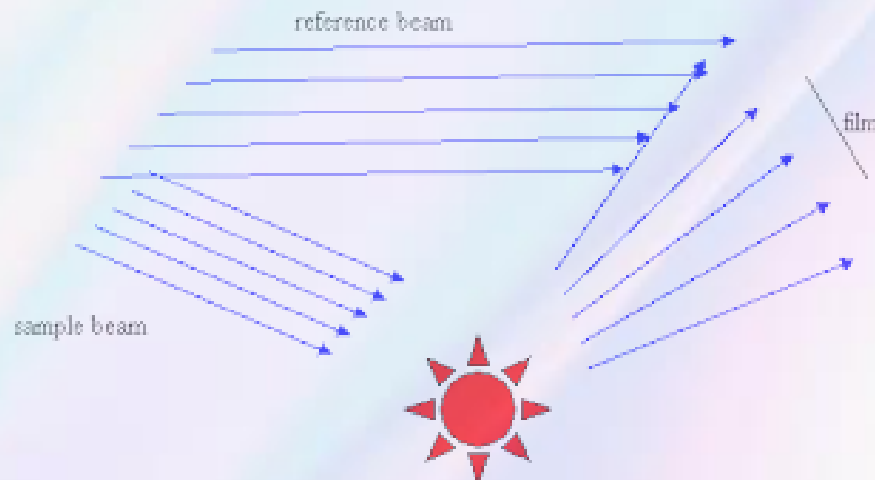
Principle of hologram

1. Object beam – light that reflects off the object and carries its information.

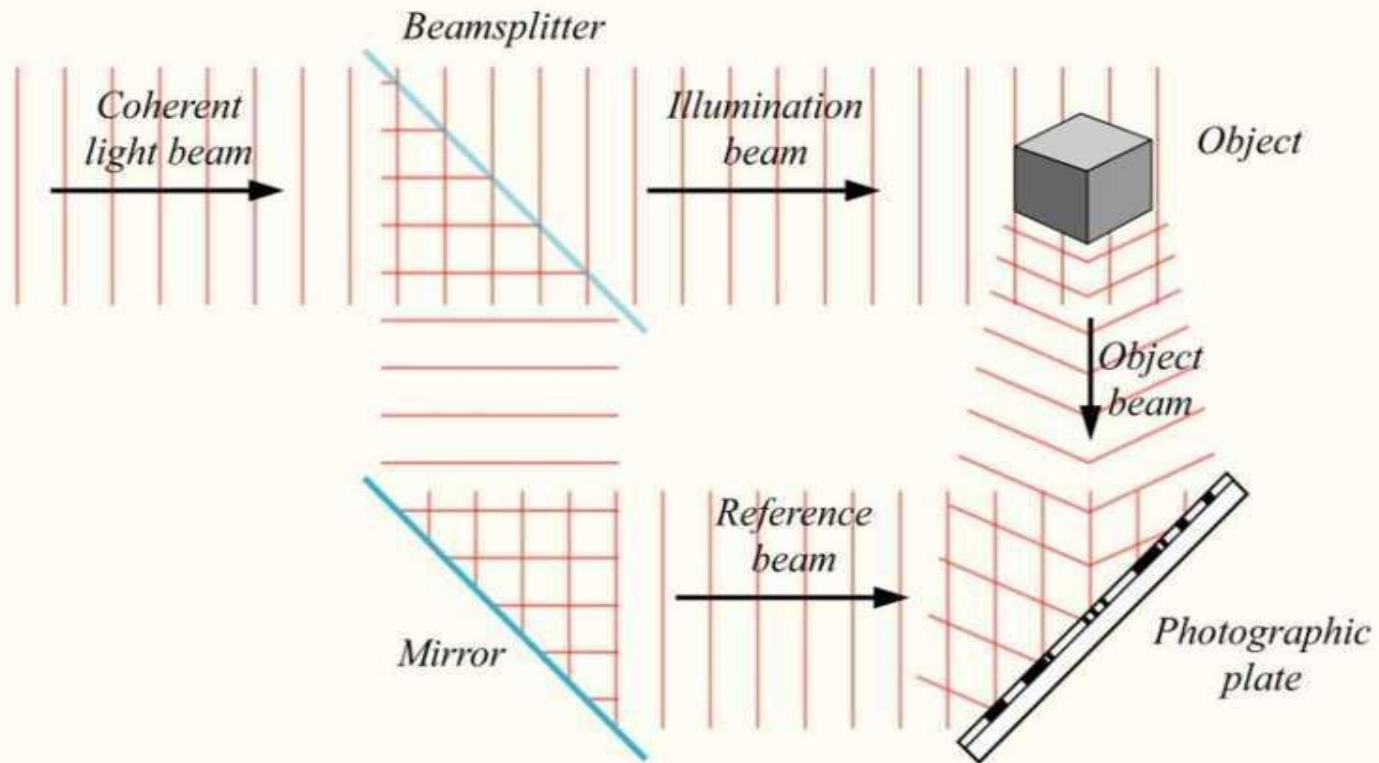
2. Reference beam – a coherent beam (usually from the same laser source) that interferes with the object beam to create an **interference pattern** on the recording medium (like a holographic plate or film).

Later, when **the reference beam** shines back through the plate, it **reconstructs** the **original 3D image** — the **hologram**.

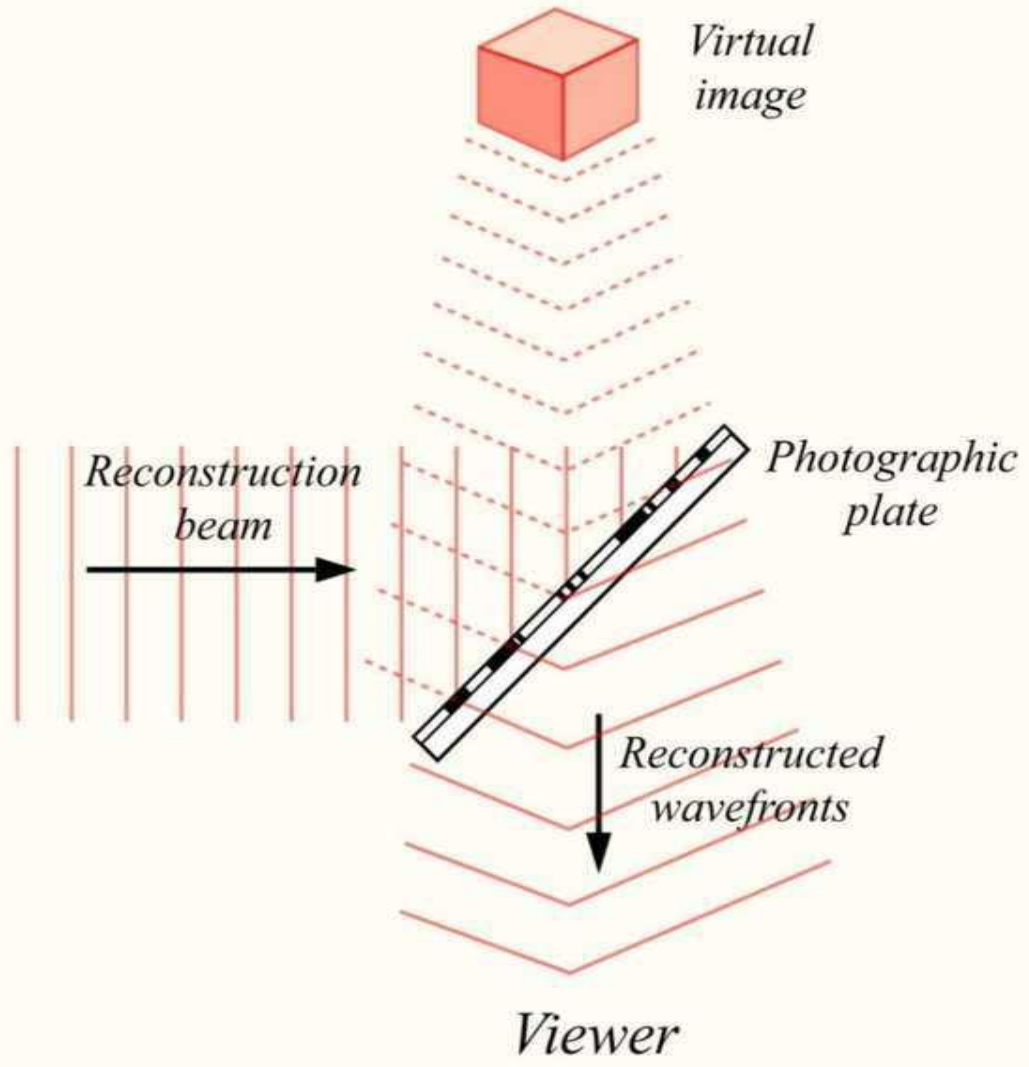
3. Each part of holographic plate **contains the whole** image. If damaged, it can still reconstruct the whole.

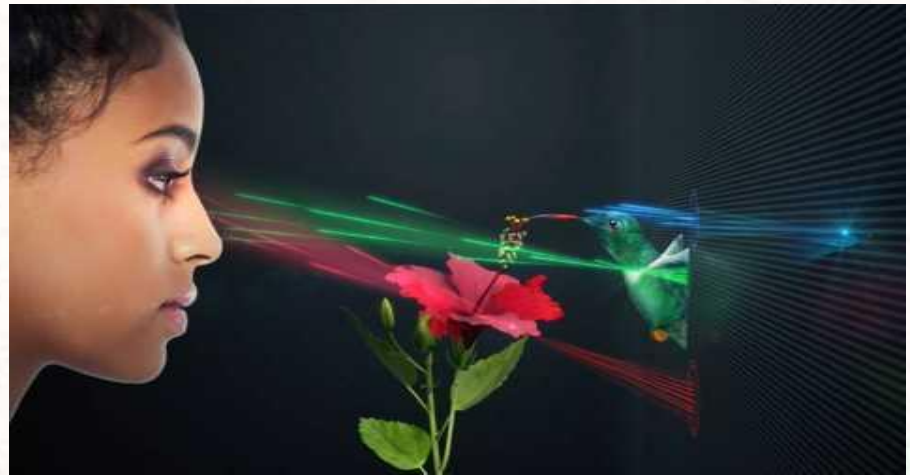


Recording a holographic picture



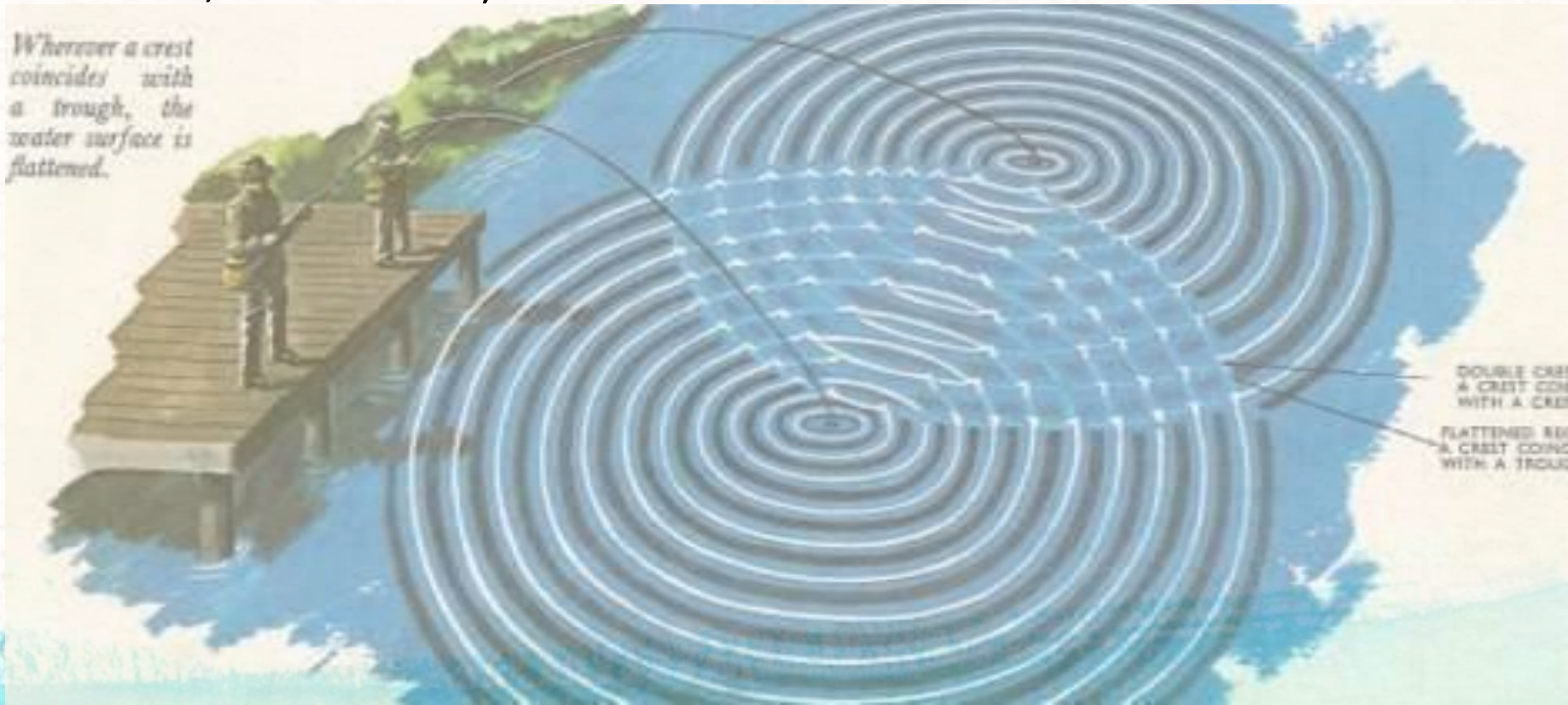
Reconstruction of an image from the holographic plate





- The **reality is a kind of interference pattern of vibrations**, of frequencies.
- Our **senses are converting the frequency domain into a seemingly objective construct** of reality (Donald Hofman, Karl Pribram).

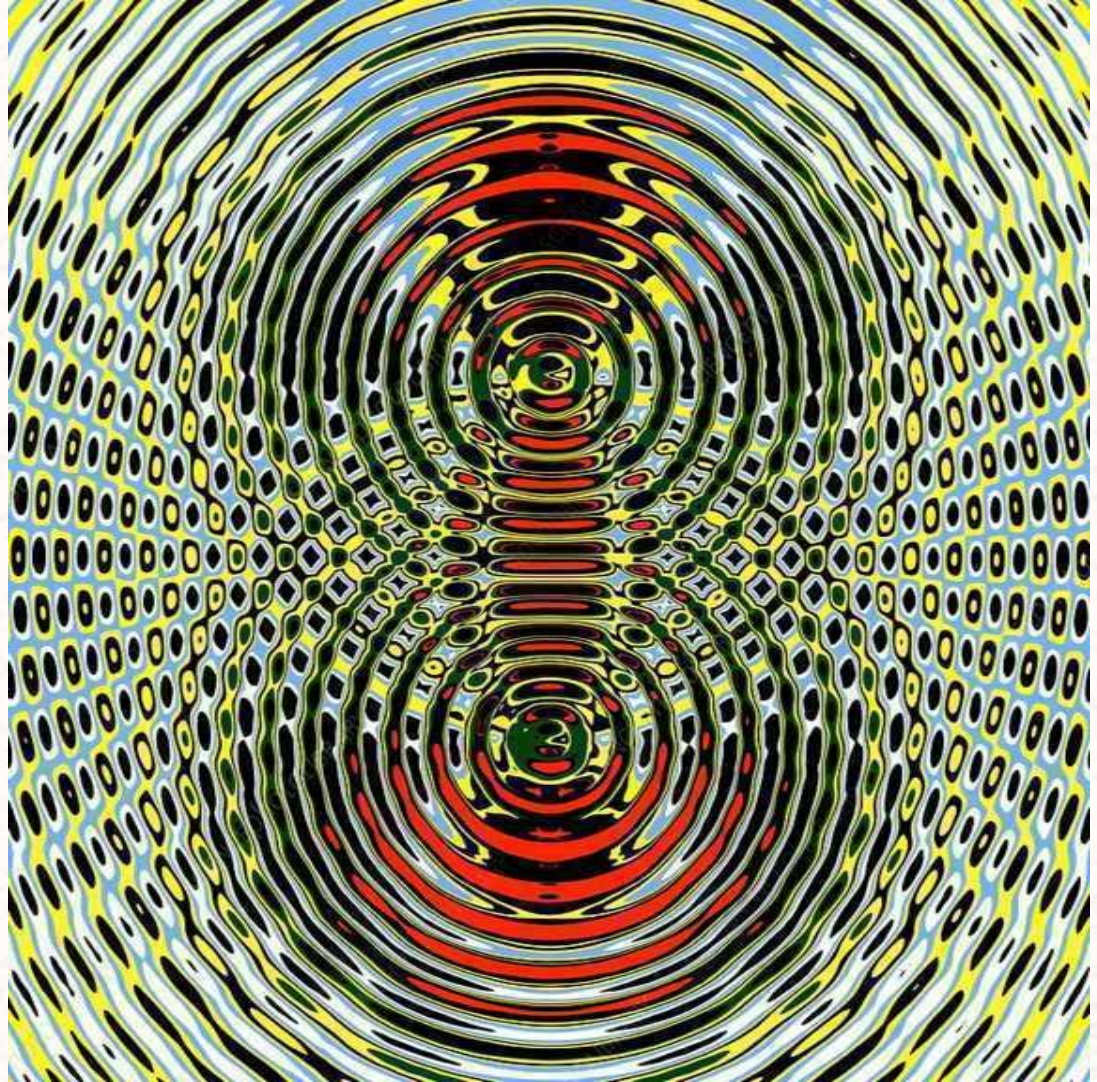
Real shape of reality

- It looks like a meaningless swirl of light and dark lines as on the picture.
- Holographic as well as fractal structure of the universe shows us repeated patterns and connectedness, whole, unified reality.

The World as an Interference of Two Lights

Reality is not something “out there” — it **arises from the meeting of two beams of light:**

1. Divine Light - the source of all — universal consciousness, pure, infinite awareness, flowing from the One. (**Reference beam** in holographic model.)

2. Inner Light - Our individual consciousness, a ray of the same divine source, but shaped by our memory, perception, and identity. (**Object beam.**)

Reality appears where these two lights meet - At the **boundary** between inner and outer, at the “Markov membrane”, their **interference creates our experience of the world.**

We are co-creating it.

We are **roles, figures** in the **dream of God**,
beams of light shaping and reflecting the world into being.

Hologram and the Homeopathic Remedy

In holography, an image does not exist on its own.

It is **reconstructed** when a coherent light beam (like a laser) interacts with a **recorded interference pattern**.

This pattern becomes visible **only when light shines on it**.

Meaning is not fixed or stored in the symbol itself.

It **emerges** only when **consciousness actively engages** with the symbol — just as light brings the hologram to life.

A **homeopathic remedy** is like a holographic interference pattern on the plate. It holds a symbolic record, not chemically, but informationally.

On its own, it does nothing.


But when consciousness engages with it, it reconstructs meaning — just like light brings a hologram to life.

The remedy acts as a **mirror**, reflecting a hidden part of the patient's inner world. Its pattern is similar to the pattern of disbalance. Elsehow there would be no resonance, no mirroring.

This resonance evokes a **conscious or unconscious response**, and a **new layer of meaning can arise** — which we experience as healing

Illness and Healing in the Holographic Model

- Illness is a break in inner coherence – a disturbance in how we make sense of our experience.
- **Illness is a distortion of meaning.**
The person gets „stuck“ in a way of feeling, thinking, or reacting, because has lost contact with a deeper inner truth.
- In holography, when the pattern is damaged, the image becomes blurry.
- In the same way, when a person´s inner pattern is out of sync with a deeper source, symptoms appear.
- **Healing** = not just removing symptoms, but **restoring coherence** between what we experience and what we deeply are.



Healing begins when consciousness engages with the symbol. This is not passive awareness — it is focused attention, like in psychotherapy, where the therapist helps the patient bring unconscious material into awareness and find new meaning.

A homeopathic **remedy** acts like a **symbolic mirror**. It **resonates** with the **internal disturbance** and invites **consciousness** (attention) to **illuminate** what was hidden.

→ This encounter can awaken a **new layer of meaning** — and that is the beginning of true **healing**.

Ambiguity and the Principle of Apeiron

Apeiron as the Source of All Meaning

- In ancient philosophy (Anaximandros), *apeiron* is the undifferentiated — a field of infinite potential, meanings are not yet distinct.
- Ambiguity reflects this state — an openness, things can mean several things at once.
- In the new paradigm, reality is not a fixed system, but an open, evolving text.

Meaning arises in the dynamic interaction between consciousness and symbol.

Ambiguity as a Return to Apeiron

- In healing, spirituality, and philosophy, we often speak of “returning to the source” — this can also mean returning to ambiguity, where new meanings can emerge.
- A homeopathic remedy evokes a symbolic image that is not clear-cut — but this ambiguity activates consciousness and leads to the integration of previously unconscious material.

Apeiron and the Quantum Field

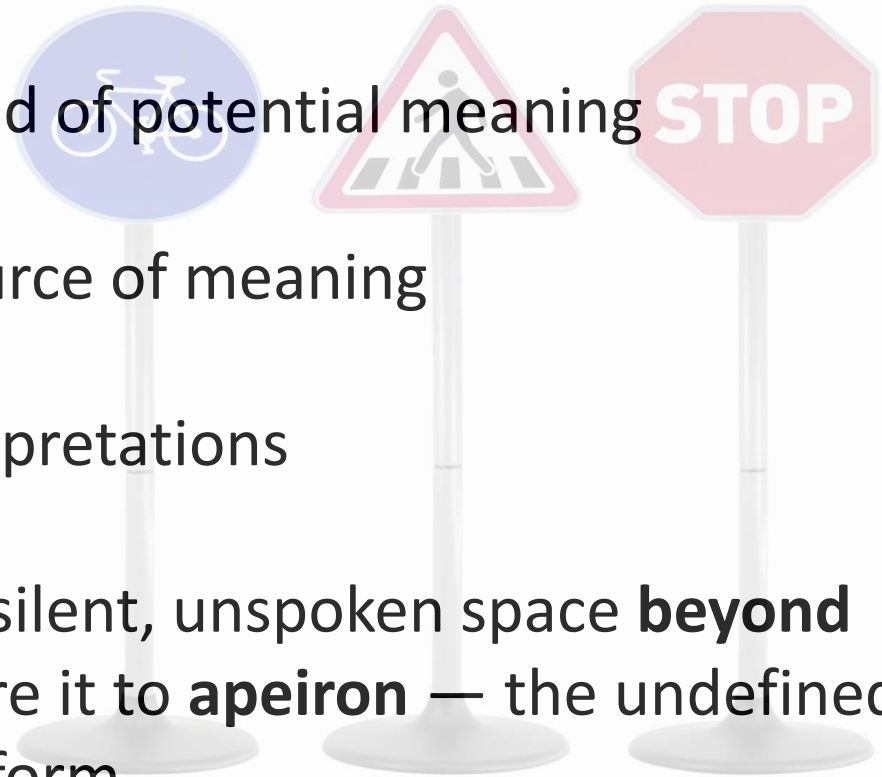
- Quantum reality is inherently ambiguous: particles exist in superposition — not either/or, but both/and — until measured. The cat is neither dead, neither alive.
- The emerging worldview replaces linear causality with probabilistic logic and resonance — the domain of *apeiron*.

The 4 Levels of Reality and Semiology

1. Meaning / Consciousness

→ **Meta-signified**, the field of potential meaning

- Consciousness is the source of meaning
- It holds all possible interpretations
- In semiology, this is the silent, unspoken space **beyond language**. We can compare it to **apeiron** — the undefined source that waits to take form.

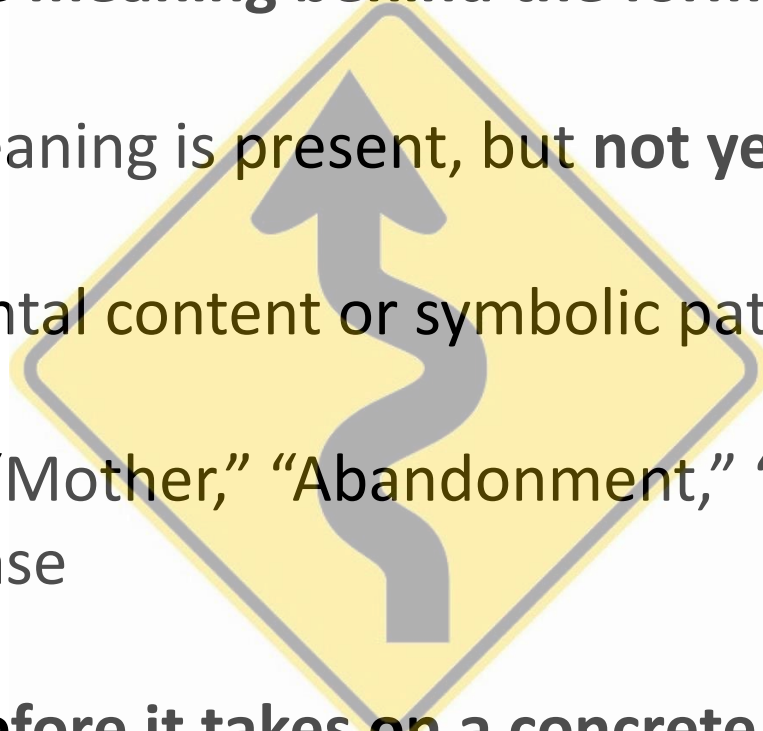


2. Information / Archetype / Pattern

→ **Signified** (the meaning behind the form)

- Archetypal meaning is present, but **not yet visible**
- This is the mental content or symbolic pattern
- For example: “Mother,” “Abandonment,” “Loss” — in a homeopathic case

It is meaning before it takes on a concrete symbol — still abstract, but already forming.



3. Energy / Dynamic Field / Vibration

→ **Signifier** (the carrier of meaning)

- The form that holds potential meaning: sound, gesture, image, remedy
- A vibration, movement, or symbolic gesture (e.g., “Sepia 200C”)
- Meaning is not yet realized — the form must be interpreted

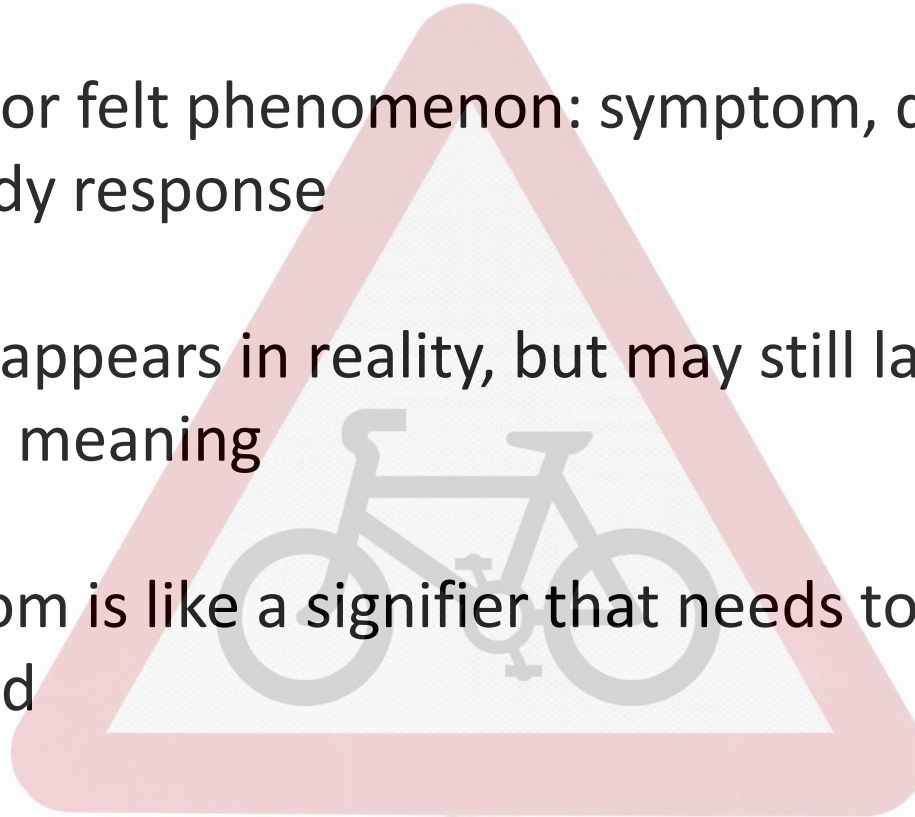
A homeopathic remedy is like a **signifier** without fixed meaning — it gains meaning only through interaction with consciousness.

4. Matter / Manifestation / Symptom

→ **Sign** (the complete unit)

- A visible or felt phenomenon: symptom, dream, image, body response
- The sign appears in reality, but may still lack integrated meaning
- A symptom is like a signifier that needs to be understood

The symptom becomes meaningful only when interpreted by consciousness.

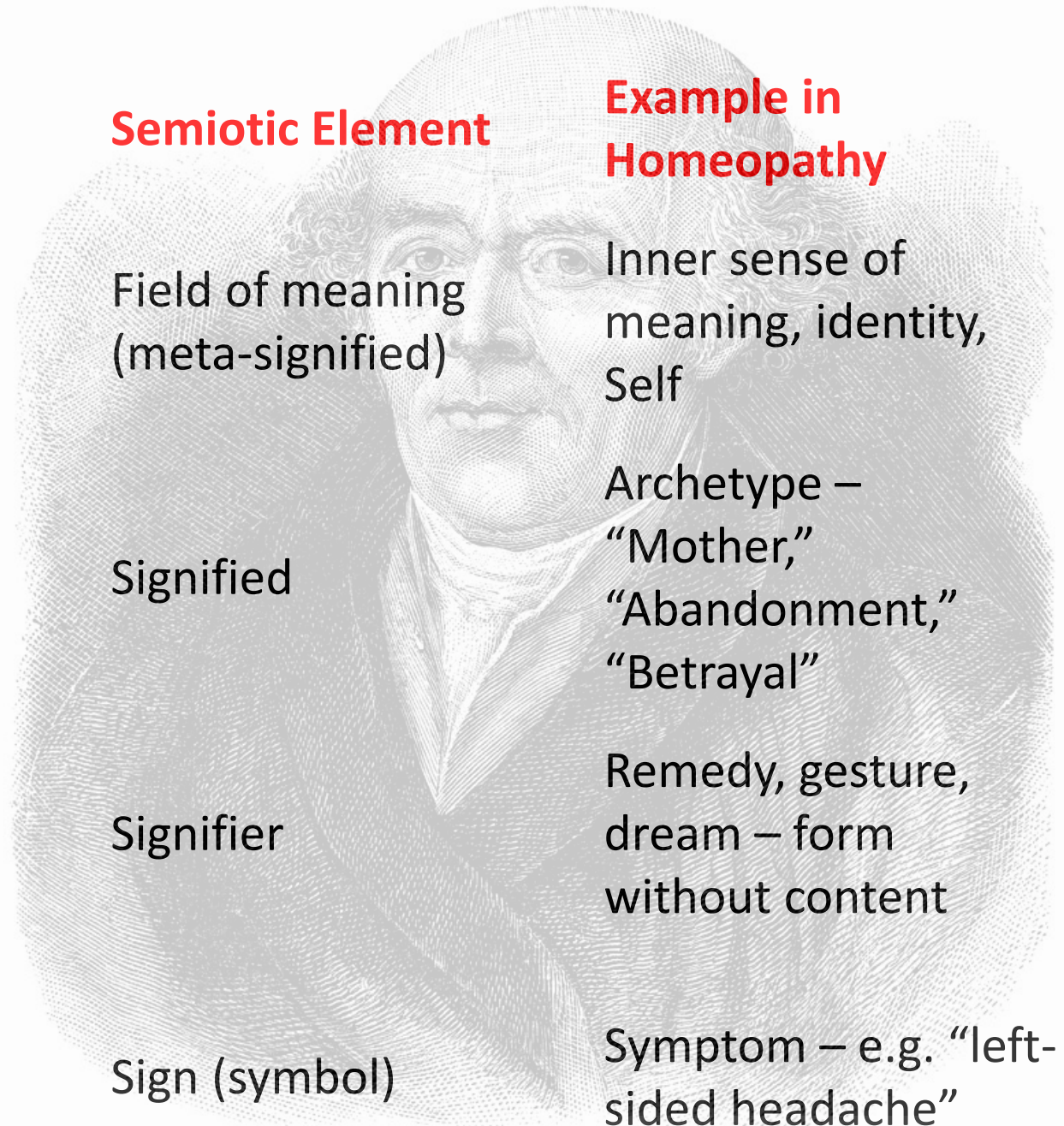

Example: **Natrum muriaticum** in the Holographic-Semiotic Model

1. Meaning / Consciousness

→ **Meta-signified** (pure potential meaning)

This is the inner Source — the origin of all symbols, patterns, and stories.

It is not broken, not traumatized — it is whole, silent, alive.

From here arise all deeper movements: love, will, identity, longing, healing.

When we are connected to this level, we feel: “I am. I belong. I am in flow with something greater.”

2. Information / Archetype / Pattern

→ **Signified** (latent meaning)

- Archetypal themes: the abandoned child, the dignified sufferer, the one who hides tears
- Emotional suppression, refined sensitivity, longing for lost connection
- Repeated patterns of emotional hurt and withdrawal

These are internal meanings waiting to find symbolic expression.

3. Energy / Vibration / Dynamic Field

→ **Signifier** (carrier of meaning)

- **The remedy *Natrum muriaticum* 200C as a symbolic form**

- It carries the emotional pattern of grief, inner tension, and suppressed expression.

- The patient resonates with the remedy because it matches their internal energetic pattern.

The remedy doesn't "add" anything — it **mirrors** what is already inside, allowing it to be seen.

4. Matter / Manifestation / Symptom

→ **Sign** (actual symptom or expression)

- Migraines from exposure to sun
- Cold sores on the lips
- Weeping while alone, worse from consolation
- Introversions, perfectionism in behavior
- These are **visible signs** — symbolic “outputs” of the inner unresolved pattern.

Why Do We Need a New Model of Homeopathy

1. The Old Model Is No Longer Sufficient

- Mechanistic and biochemical paradigms cannot explain how ultra-diluted remedies work.
- Even the traditional **vital force** model seems **outdated** or unclear to many practitioners and patients.
- New discoveries in **quantum theory, systems thinking, and information science** demand an updated framework.

We need a model that honors **complexity, immateriality, and meaning.**

2. It Clarifies the Symbolic Nature of the Remedy

- A homeopathic remedy is not a chemical agent, but a **carrier of symbolic information**.
- It acts not by force, but by **resonating with a disrupted pattern** within the patient.
- This model shows us why choosing the right remedy is about finding a match with the patient's inner experience and personal story.

The remedy functions more like a question than an answer.

3. It Bridges Homeopathy and Psychotherapy

- Like in psychotherapy, healing occurs when **consciousness engages with symbol and meaning.**
- Both disciplines rely on resonance, insight, and transformation through awareness.
- The holographic model offers a common language for deeper integration of healing modalities.

It unites body and psyche without dualism.



4. It Restores Credibility Through a Contemporary Framework

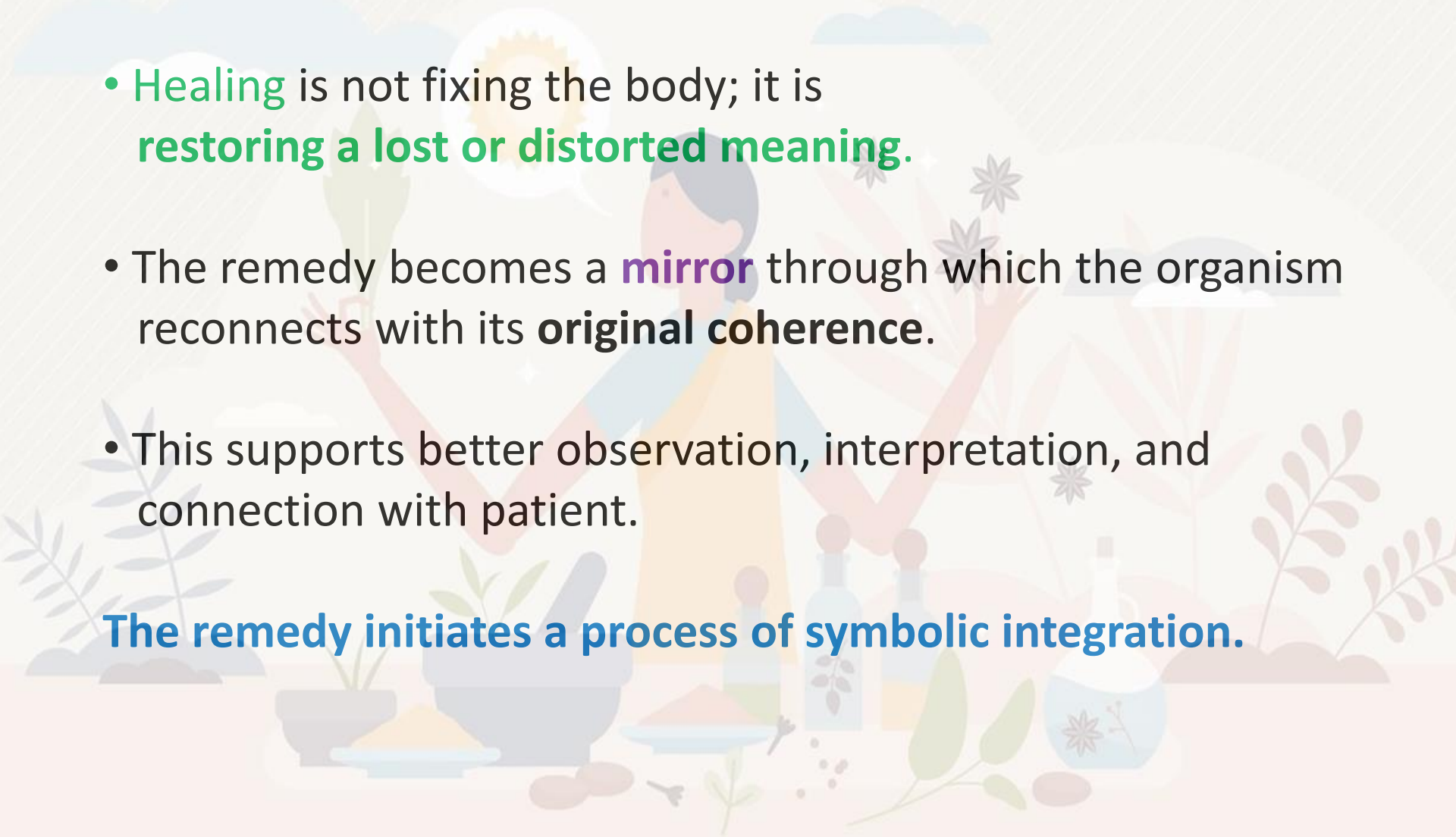
- Instead of vague ideas like “vital energy,” we speak in terms of **information, resonance, and meaning.**
- This approach connects homeopathy with serious philosophical and scientific traditions:
David Bohm, Karl Pribram, Rupert Sheldrake, and others.
- It allows us to participate in a broader **cultural and scientific dialogue.**

We gain a modern, meaningful, and interdisciplinary language.

5. It Deepens the Practitioner's Understanding of Healing

- **Healing** is not fixing the body; it is **restoring a lost or distorted meaning.**
- The remedy becomes a **mirror** through which the organism reconnects with its **original coherence.**
- This supports better observation, interpretation, and connection with patient.

The remedy initiates a process of symbolic integration.



6. It Explains Radionic and Noetic Remedy Preparation

- This model also accommodates **non-traditional methods** of remedy creation, such as:
 - **Radionic remedies** made via intention and subtle field imprinting,
 - or the **“noetic” method**, where the name of a remedy is written on paper, and a glass of water is placed on top,
 - or even **simply thinking of the remedy**, and it begins to act.
- These practices cannot be explained through chemistry — but in an **informational and symbolic paradigm**, they make sense:

The remedy functions as a symbolic pattern that interacts with consciousness.

The essence of the remedy is not in the substance, but in the informational field it represents.

7. It Facilitates Emergence of a New Paradigm

- In this paradigm, homeopathy and other forms of alternative healing are seen as completely natural and legitimate.
- They are no longer marginalized or questioned — they become an integral part of the healthcare system.
- People seek out homeopaths without hesitation, because these methods are understood as working on a deeper, holistic level of human experience and meaning.

8. It Supports the Survival of Humanity and the Planet

The new paradigm fosters awareness that all beings arise from the same source.

Our differences are superficial — they reflect unique roles in a shared reality.

This shift in consciousness leads to:

- **deeper empathy,**
- **genuine cooperation,**
- **responsible care for the Earth.**

Only through a holistic and unified worldview can we overcome division, exploitation, and ecological collapse.

We do not just need new technologies — we need a new way of **being**.
